

SELF-ADHESIVE PROJECTION SCREENS

Instructions for using self-adhesive projection screens

Gerriets offers its customers the option of adding a self-adhesive layer to all types of projection screens, starting at 10 running meters and with a maximum width of 1.60 meters.

Please note the following installation instructions:

- The adhesive layer is applied to the back of the projection screen.
- The adhesive layer must face away from the viewer.
- Despite careful coating, irregularities may occur in the projection surface.
- The irregularities in the coating may be particularly visible in rear projection.
- These irregularities in the coating may also be visible in front projection.
- The adhesive layer must not be applied to coated or sensitive surfaces.
No liability can be accepted for any damage.
- No guarantee can be given for the residue-free removal of the adhesive films.

- The projection properties of a projection film can be affected by the application of an adhesive layer.
- The projection screens and adhesive coating are not UV-stable and therefore not suitable for permanent installation.
- The adhesive coating causes the projection screen to lose its flame retardant certification.
