

Mounting instructions magnetic mounting plates

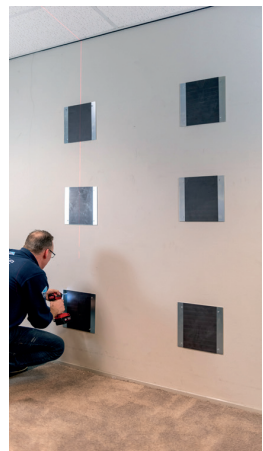
1. Checking the condition of the wall

Remove protruding parts such as old screws or other disturbing factors.

2. Marking the drill holes

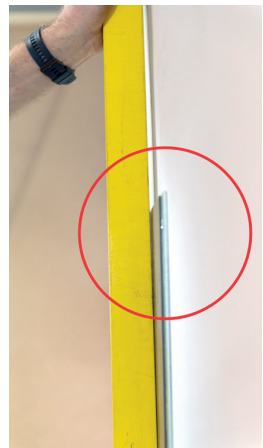
For smaller infoboards with only one magnetic mounting plate:
Hold the magnetic plate at the desired position and mark the drill holes of the magnetic plate on the wall.

For larger infoboards with multiple magnetic mounting plates:
We will provide you project-specific installation instructions with a recommendation where to place the mounting plates.
As a general rule, the magnetic mounting plates should be positioned 10 cm from the edge of the information panel.
To do this, draw vertical horizontal guide lines on the wall.
Hold the mounting plates and mark the drill holes.
If necessary, for extra large infoboards in the middle or in the case of lined up infoboards, additional mounting plates should be attached to the butt edges.



3. Fastening the magnetic plate

Depending on the wall, use the appropriate dowels (included in delivery: dowels for stone walls).
When tightening the screws, the magnet plate must not bend.
If it bends nevertheless, the screw may be loosened a little.
However, the screw must not protrude in front of the magnet surface.
When you have attached all the magnetic plates, check with a spirit level whether the plates are in balance with each other.
If a magnetic plate is not in contact with the level, you can place leveling wedges under the mounting plate.



4. Position infoboard

Position your infoboard centered in the magnet area.

Important for the full adhesive force of the magnet:
The magnetic surface in its entirety must be in contact with the back of the board in order to develop its full adhesive force.
